Retention and Graduation Report: Introduction

The report is Retention and Graduation for 10 years of entering baccalaureate degree-seeking cohort. Students included in each cohort were those 1) registered in a first entry bachelor program and admitted in the fall term of the past 10 years, 2) had not attended a postsecondary institution prior to attending Brock, and 3) were full-time and took an equivalent of two full courses in the fall term at time of entry. In summary, only first-time full-time first entry bachelor degree seeking students were included in the cohort of each year.

Section 1 (1a and 1b) includes retention and graduation information for students tracked from their first year at Brock. The following are the details:

Section 1a Retention and Graduation - Tracking First Year (Program) Students. It reports retention and graduation for students entering Brock in a particular program. Using the table for Program A (below) as an example: There were a total of 23 students started Program A in fall 2000, in fall 2001, 23 of the 23 (100%) enrolled, 22 (95.7%) continued in program A and 1 (4.3%) enrolled in another program; in fall 2002, 22 (95.7%) of the 23 students in the entry cohort were enrolled, 19 (82.6% of the original 23) were enrolled in Program A and 3 (13.0%) were enrolled in other programs; in fall 2003, 17 (73.9% of the 23 students) were enrolled, 16 (69.6% of the original cohort) continued in Program A and 1 (4.3%) was enrolled in another program; by fall 2006, 21 (91.3% of the 23 students in the initial cohort) graduated/completed their study, of which 18 (78.3% of 23) completed/graduated in program A and 3 (13% of 23) completed/graduated in other programs. The charts on page 2 & 3 illustrate retention and graduation rates of each cohort group by gender.

Section 1b (Page 4 - 6) Retention and Graduation - Tracking First Year: Comparison -- Program, Faculty and Brock. This report compares retention and graduation rates for students started in a particular program, students started in the Faculty where the program is offered, and all students started in the same year at Brock. Using the table for Program A (below) as an example: For the 2000 entry cohort, the first year to second year retention rate for students started in program A was 100% in comparison to 89.9% for students started in the Faculty where Program A is offered and 89.8% for all students started in the same year at Brock; the first year to third year retention rates for students in the forementioned three groups were 95.7%, 73.9%, and 75.2%; the first year to fourth year retention rates were 73.9%, 66.2%, and 67.7%; by fall 2006, 91.3% of the students started in Program A had either graduated or completed their study, only 67.6% of the students started in the Faculty (where Program A belongs) had either graduated or completed their studies and 72.7% of all students started in the same year at Brock had either graduated or completed their studies. The charts illustrate the above comparisons for each of the cohort groups.

Retention and Graduation Report: Introduction

Section 2 (2a and 2b) includes retention and graduation information for students tracked from their second year at Brock. The following are the details:

Section 2a Retention and Graduation - Tracking from Second Year: (Program). It reports retention and graduation for students entered Brock in a particular year. These students were tracked from their second year at Brock and by the program they were enrolled at their second year. Using the table for Program A (below) as an example: There were a total of 23 students started Program A in fall 2000, in fall 2001, a total of 30 students (out of Brock's entry cohort of fall 2000) enrolled in Program A at their second year, of the 30 students enrolled in Program A at their second year, 22 (73.3% of the 30) started in program A in fall 2000 and 8 (26.7%) started in other programs in fall 2000; in fall 2002, 28 of the 30 students (93.3%) were enrolled at Brock, of these 28 students enrolled, 26 (86.7% of the 30) were enrolled in Program A and 2 (6.6%) were enrolled in other programs; in fall 2003, 22 (73.3% of the 30 students) were enrolled, and all of the 22 continued in Program A; by fall 2006, 27 (90.0% of the 30 students) had either graduated or completed their studies, of which 25 (83.3% of 30) had graduated or completed their studies in Program A and 2 (6.7% of 30) had graduated or completed their studies in other programs. The charts on page 8 & 9 illustrate retention and graduation rates by program and by gender of each cohort group.

Section 2b Retention and Graduation - Tracking from Second Year: Comparison -- Program, Faculty and Brock. This report compares retention and graduation rates for students in a particular program, students in the Faculty where the program is offered, and all students at Brock. Using the table for Program A (below) as an example: The first part are the first year to second year retention rates for students started in program A in comparison to that for students started in the Faculty where Program A is offered and that for all students started in the same year at Brock; The follolwoing parts are results from tracking students at their second year: the second year to third year retention rates were 93.3% for students who were enrolled in Program A in fall 2001 (i.e their second year), in comparison to 84.7% for students enrolled in the Faculty in their second year and 88.2% for all students enrolled in Program A at their second year had either graduated or completed their study, in comparison to 78.5% for the students enrolled in the Faculty (where Program A belongs) at their second year and 81.0% for all students enrolled at Brock at their second year. The charts illustrate the above comparisons for the three groups in each cohort year.
