The picture in the right is for a quiz that runs for 120 minutes, note that your weekly quiz is a 50-minutes test.




## Gateway Quiz Weekly\_Quiz\_01

It only shows you that your answer is readable by WW.
- 2- When you enter your answer as a fraction, WW will consider the whole calculated number. Note that this may not work if you need to report your result rounded to a specific number of sig fig.
